



## Follow a winding river to places unknown

Unlike an ocean cruise, a journey down a meandering inland waterway can take you right to the heart of a country and there's an itinerary to suit every taste, says Pat Richardson

ne of the biggest on opean cruise and a river cruise is that the former takes you to countries, while the latter takes you through countries, mulcing river cruising in many ways a more immersive experience. And with itineraries to match every interest or passion there's no compromise on choice. Here's our round-up of the best in a selection of popular holiday categories.

Scenic splendour

The serone Moselle meanders through a picture-book landscape of vincyard clud hills and a succession of half-timbered medieval towns and villages. New kid on the dock, Emerald Waterways (0800 270 7017; emeraldwaterways, co.uk) offers a 12-day Rhine and Moselle cruise on Emerald Sky departing on April 15, 2014

(from £1,945 per person).

There's show-stopping scenery,
too, on the Danube's 1,777-mile sweep across Europe from Black Forest to Black Sea, most notably in the Wachau Valley between Melk and Krems, where church spires, pastle turrets and abboy towers soar and cultivated terraces spill down mountain slopes. Most itineraries offer optional excursions to Melk Abbey, for views from its cliffton terraces The River Cruise Line (0844 544 6437; rivereruiseline.co.uk) has a 10 day round-trip cruise from

'Three of Europe's grand capitals, Vienna, Bratislava and Budapest, feature on a number of Danube cruises, Avalon Waterways (0808 115 2758; avaloncruises.co.uk) offers a Vienna-to-Budapest Taste of the Danube cruise on Avalon Allinity, combining a three day cruise with a two-night stay in each of Vienna and Budapest. From £1,755pp for departures

from May to September 2014.

Paris is usually the launch point for cruises along the Seine with time to enjoy the city before heading farther ofield. Great Rail Journeys (01904 521982; greatmil.com) offers a selection of seven day cruises on board the three-star converted on odard in three-state cantered harge. Anacoluthe. All sailings include an illuminated evening cruise through Paris, from £1,225pp, departing March to November 2014.



Many Danube cruises include visits to the Holburg Palace in Vienna. An itinerary offered by Avalon Waterways (0808 115 2758; avaloneruises.co.uk) includes this plus, in Germany, the fairy-tale Kouschwanstein Castle - one of the most popular of all Europe's palaces and castles - and the Versailles-inspired Linderhol Palace, both built for King Ludwig II of Bavaria. There is also a visit to Munich's baroque Nymphenburg Palace. where Ludwig was born. The ilinerary combines a five-night cruise on Avelon Artistry II with three nights in Munich, from £2,055pp for departures May

New and unusual

Only recently opened to international navigation, the Tisza rises in Ukruine, flows across the Great Hungarian Plain and into the Danube near Novi Sad, in Serbia. The Hungarian Puszta, one of the largest stretches of

meadow land in Europe, features on a nine-day round-trip cruise on the Tisza from Budapest, offered by CroistEurope (020 8328 128); croistEurope.travel). There's also an excursion to the Tokaj wine region. The trip costs from £1,165pp cruise only, departing in May and June 2014.

September 2014 from £1,795pp. Following the launch of cruises on the Mississippi in America's Deep South on a renovated paddlewheel steamer. the American Queen Steamboat Company (001 888 749 5280: americanqueensteamboatcompany. com) has turned its attention to the stunning scenery of the Pacific Northwest.
