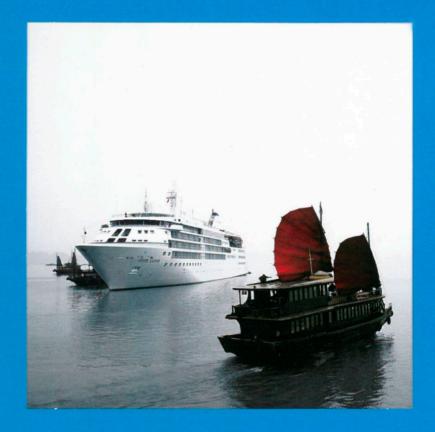

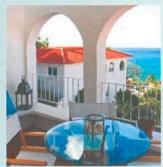

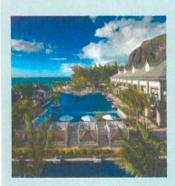
BECOME FAMOUS:

Aqua's third ship makes Mekong debut

Aqua Expeditions' third vessel will launch this October as small-ship luxury cruising continues to grow in Asia.

The Aqua Mekong will voyage its namesake river through Cambodia and Vietnam offering three, four and seven-night itineraries from Angkor Wat gateway Siem Reap to My Tho, near Saigon and vice versa, stopping in Phnom Penh.

The vessel is a sister to the company's two other vessels on the Peruvian Amazon and features 20 suites with floor-to-ceiling windows, a spa and fitness centre, library, screening room and observation deck with pool and lounge bar. The menu is by Michelin-starred David Thompson, the chef behind Nahm at the Metropolitan by Como in Bangkok.

The UK accounts for about 20% of business, which Aqua plans to increase with the help of UK trade sales and training representative Malcolm Macfarlane. Agents earn 10% commission with Aqua and voyages are also bookable through operators such as Abercrombie & Kent, Bales Worldwide, Cox & Kings and Audley.
